- ***European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD)***
Based in London, the EBRD has operations in 34 countries from Central Europe to Central Asia, and through its financial investments, business services and involvement in high-level policy dialogue, the Bank supports the transition to market economies, whilst promoting innovation, growth and transparency.
- ***Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD)***
Headquartered in Paris, the mission of the OECD is to promote policies that will improve the economic and social well-being of people around the world. The OECD uses its wealth of information on a broad range of topics to help governments of 34 member countries foster prosperity and fight poverty through economic sustainable growth and financial stability.
- ***International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD)***
Located in Rome, IFAD is a specialised agency of the United Nations, and was established as an international financial institution in 1977 as one of the major outcomes of the 1974 World Food Conference. IFAD has focused exclusively on rural poverty reduction, working with poor rural populations in developing countries to eliminate poverty, hunger and malnutrition; raise their productivity and incomes; and improve the quality of their lives.
