- Develop metrics and reports to monitor the services, propose methods for improvement.
- Provide training and advice to end-users and potential users.
- Provide ad-hoc reports to management.
- Administer Hyper-V and virtualization services chargeback system.
- Provide "stand-by" services on a rotation basis during weekends, holidays and outside of normal working hours.
