The programme spans the WHO Division of Medicines and Health Products, and the WHO Department of Neglected Tropical Diseases, and will be guided by a multi-stakeholder roadmap launched during the World Health Assembly, May 2019. Throughout the assignment, the JPO will collaborate with teams across the Department of Equitable Access to Medicines and Health Products, across the division of Medicines and Health Products, as well as with relevant regional and global health initiatives (Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria, GAVI Alliance, UNITAID etc.) and United Nations organizations.</p> <p>Supervisor: Group Lead, Blood products and other Biologicals, Technologies Standards and Norms Team, Department of Equitable Access to Medicines and Health Products</p>
