DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the overall authority of the Assistant Director-General for Education (ADG/ED), the functional authority of the Director of the UNESCO Multi-sectoral Regional Office in Dakar and the Head of Education sector, and the direct supervision of the Responsible of Teaching and Learning (T&L) Cluster, the incumbent will support the application of UNESCO's recommendations for the integration of ICTs into education policies in West African countries. Within this context, the JPO will be responsible for:

1. <u>Technical assistance in drawing up policies, projects and programmes</u> <u>integrating the use of ICT in education</u>

- Assisting countries in the prospective analysis of ICTs available at the various levels of education systems;
- Assist countries in the development of master plans for the integration of ICT and AI into the various levels and types of education;
- Assisting UNESCO's technical teams in drawing up programmes and work plans integrating ICT and AI in education ;
- Contribute to the evaluation of costs related to the use of ICT and AI in the programming process of activities implemented by UNESCO;
- Develop a regional roadmap for the integration of ICT and AI in education.

2. <u>Technical assistance in implementing policies, projects and programmes</u> <u>integrating the use of ICT in education</u>

- Supporting the implementation of ICT and AI-related activities in countries' education policies;
- Support the process of setting up distance learning platforms and other methods of using ICTs and AI in education;
- Ensure quality monitoring and control of the implementation of services related to the use of ICTs and AI, including distance learning platforms commissioned by UNESCO.
- Ensure the implementation of the regional roadmap for the integration of ICT and AI in education.



- 3. <u>Capacity building for stakeholders in the use of ICTs, including distance learning platforms</u>
- Support institutional capacity-building in countries equipped to promote ICT and AI in education,
- Contribute to the preparation and running of capacity-building sessions for country players on the integration of ICTs and AI into teaching policies;
- Contribute to capacity-building sessions for stakeholders on the use of distance learning platforms.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

Education

• Advanced university degree (Master's or equivalent) in IT, AI, techno-pedagogy or related fields.

Work Experience

- A minimum of two (2) years of professional experience as a central player or platform manager in distance learning; of which preferably one (1) year acquired at international level;
- A minimum of one (1) year of professional experience in using of tools such as Photoshop and Illustrator, AI;
- Experience in storyboard.

Skills & Competencies

- Proficiency in e-learning authoring tools and audio and video editing tools;
- Very good command of programming languages such as Java, Python, PHP, C#, HTML, CSS and JavaScript, AI tools, as well as a good understanding of databases and content management systems;
- Mastery of security and compliance standards (SCORM, LTI, etc.);
- Good knowledge of educational technology;
- Ability to provide expert advice to policy and decision makers.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills, including the ability to prepare, present and discuss findings and recommendations clearly and concisely.
