AFRO	AF/22/02	Health Emergencies Programme	Brazzaville, Republic of Congo	Project Officer	<p>As a member of the global Eliminate Yellow Fever Epidemics (EYE) strategy's Africa Regional team, a key role of the Junior Professional Officer will be to coordinate the mapping, surveillance and outreach of the private sector (primarily the extractive industry) in order to support the introduction of innovations and enhanced strategies to ensure the protection of migrant populations from yellow fever, and prevent onward transmission in high-risk and hard to reach areas of Africa. This is a critically unaddressed area and key priority for the second half of the 10-year (2017-26) EYE strategy.</p> <p>The JPO will additionally support the smooth and efficient running of EYE Strategy implementation in Africa through administrative and data management activities which will include, project management, partnership, communications and event management, work planning, monitoring and evaluation (M&amp;E) and record keeping activities to enhance the global yellow fever prevention and control agenda.</p> <p>On a daily basis, the JPO will collaborate closely with a coalition of partners at regional and country levels who aim to protect over 1 billion people globally from yellow fever by 2026. The high-profile partners to the Strategy include the Bill &amp; Melinda Gates Foundation, Gavi, UNICEF, WHO and the US CDC, while regional and national partners involve 27 high-risk African countries and multiple stakeholders. This opportunity will enable the JPO to hone their public health coordination, management, and technical skills within a global programme and develop a deep and practical understanding of WHO's mandate within Africa.</p> <p>The work of the JPO will contribute directly to WHO's Thirteenth General Programme of Work (GPW 13), namely, on prevention strategies for priority pandemic-/epidemic-prone diseases being implemented at scale and towards ensuring all at-risk populations are protected from yellow fever, international spread of yellow fever is prevented, and yellow fever outbreaks are rapidly contained by 2026.</p> <p>Supervisor: Medical Officer</p>
